


SUPPORTING FAMILIES TO IMPLEMENT & REVIEW THEIR CHILD'S NDIS PLAN



Schools can support families at each stage of the NDIS pathway. This fact sheet focuses on the fourth and fifth stage.

How schools can support families as they implement their child's NDIS plan

- Encourage families to share their NDIS-funded supports and discuss if and how schools can support them to implement their plan (Note – families are not required to disclose this information)
- Manage requests from parents or carers for NDIS funded supports to be delivered at school, and support them to understand that access to the school is at the discretion of the principal
- Continue to support the application process and day-to-day operations of the Assisted School Travel Program.

How schools can support families during the review of their child's NDIS plan

- On request, provide copies of existing assessments, reports or other information related to a child's disability to inform a plan review. Schools are not required to complete new reports for the NDIS
- On request, advise families on additional supports that could benefit a child and encourage them to raise it during the plan review
- School staff may participate in the plan review process, if asked by families and where operationally convenient. This participation may be in person or over the phone
