Hello Everyone,

Good news!! I have been successful in obtaining another grant from Liverpool City Council's Community Grant program for \$5,000.00. The project is "Harmony in Design". We will once again be engaging the services of Natalie Valiente from Hands of Clay to help us design and paint some murals and mosaic artworks for the senior playground and for the areas around classrooms 7 and 8. Flyers will be sent home in the next few weeks for parents/carers who wish to join the group to make mosaics and help paint the murals.

Another exciting event LPS is planning is the Stepping Stones Triple P project which is a behaviour modification program specifically designed for the challenging behaviours of children with special needs. We all need help with those behaviours!!! We are currently in negotiations with program providers to run the program at Les Powell School in Term 1, 2017. Expressions of Interest will be sent out shortly to ascertain interest in this project.

Another project we are looking into is a Mobile Dental Clinic—also planned for Term 1, 2017. Negotiations are under way to get that happening at the school to save parents and carers travelling time to and from a Dental appointment.

A final NDIS workshop is being planned before the end of Term 4 to help us through the mine filed of understanding the changes that are coming and what we need to know.

Please also note that the parent day out has now been changed to Wednesday 30th November. A flyer will be sent home with all the details about 2 weeks beforehand
