SwimFin

The swimfin is a new swimming buoyancy aid designed to cater for the beginner, intermediate and advanced swimmer. Worn on the back, it doesn't affect or restrict the ability to move in the water. Swimfin is a floatation device that provides as much buoyancy as the swimmer needs while helping maintain a good position in the water.

With swimfin the lower you are in the water the more support it will give you, as with the beginner swimmer. The higher you are in the water the less support it will give you, as with an improved swimmer. Swimfin compensates for different abilities.

It's multi stroke functionality allows it to be used for crawl, back stoke, breast stroke and fly.
